## 2018 Parade Day Participants Instructions

Parade - Saturday, May 26, 2018 - 12:00 noon

Route - State St. from Lake to Van Buren. All units should be in place by 10am

Unit name National Women Veterans United (NWVU)

Your parade unit number is 36

Your assembly area is on Wacker Drive between State  
and Dearborn street

**Assembly Area:** Your unit will assemble on Wacker Drive between the two streets listed above. Your bus can drop-off on one of the two streets listed above at Wacker. Wacker will be closed to traffic. Each block of Wacker will have a Parade Marshal to assist you with your assigned location. Please make sure each member of your unit knows your parade unit number.

**Disbanding/Bus Parking:** The parade will end at Van Buren Street. Marching units will disband westbound on Van Buren. Buses and support vehicles will park on the north and south curb lane of Van Buren from Plymouth Court to Wacker Drive. Make sure your group knows your bus number. Floats will proceed south bound on State to Congress.

**Parking:** Participants need to make their own parking arrangements. The disbanding area is for buses and support vehicles only. All other vehicles will be towed.

**Unit numbers:** The parade marshal in your assigned assembly area will give you your unit number. The unit number will be displayed at the front right-hand side of your unit. The unit number must be visible to the Reviewing Stand for the announcer to identify and announce your unit.

**Reviewing Stand:** The reviewing Stand will be located on the west curb lane of State Street just north of Madison.

**Portable Restrooms:** Portable restrooms will be located in the assembly and disbanding area and along the parade route.

*You must provide your own banners or signs for your unit.*
